Information for Summer Youth Program Positions

Dates/Time/Location

The Town of Niskayuna will operate morning camps at four locations in 2010. The Town also operates the Town Pool, the Driving Range and various other programs throughout the summer.

- Hillside School and Avon Crest Park will serve children entering pre-K through grade 7 from July 6th through August 6th from 9am to 12pm.
- River Road Park will serve children entering pre-K to grade 2; while Blatnick Park will serve children entering grades 3 to 7 from July 6th through August 6th from 9am to 12pm.
- Other programs will be announced as they become available.

Youth Position Descriptions:

Counselor in training (CIT) - This is an volunteer (unpaid) position designed for applicants entering Grades 8 or older. The position assists counselors in supervising children at the playground or other Town-sponsored camps.

Counselor- This is a paid position designed for applicants entering grade 9 or above, with either prior camp (CIT) experience, or prior child care experience (references needed). Counselors are responsible for direct supervision of children, ages 3 to 12, may lead activities and report to the Camp Director.

Specialist- This is a paid position designed for applicants entering grade 10 and above who are capable of leading instruction in a specialized activity. Examples include basketball, tennis, skateboarding, soccer, lacrosse, baseball, arts and craft, fishing or other camp activities.

Lifeguard- this is a paid position for individuals who have completed a lifesaving course and hold a current lifeguard certification.
