

REXFORD BRIDGE PROJECT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – October 14, 2016

There are three construction activities that are coming up in the next week starting tonight that will impact travelers in the project area.

Aqueduct Road – Friday, October 14 – Saturday, October 15

This Friday night, October 14th, and on Saturday, October 15th, a short section Aqueduct Road where it approaches the roundabout next to Rexford Bridge will be reconstructed and paved. No closure or detour will be required for this work. There will be alternating one-way traffic with flaggers controlling traffic. Traffic delays are expected on both Route 146 and Aqueduct Road. Other work not requiring any lane closures will also be occurring this weekend.

North Main Street – Monday, October 17 – Friday, October 21

The North entrance to Main Street at Route 146/Balltown Road will be closed to install a drainage culvert. The South entrance to Main Street will remain **OPEN** for everyone (motorists, bicycles and pedestrians) to access Main Street, Cole Street, Church Road and Bluff Road.

Route 146/Balltown Road - Friday, October 21 – Monday, October 24

Beginning at 9:00 PM October 21st, a section of Route 146/Balltown Road just south of the Rexford Bridge roundabout at Aqueduct Road will be closed to traffic in both directions to allow paving work associated with the Rexford Bridge project to progress. While the closure must end by 6:00 AM Monday October 24th, the contractor expects to have the road back open to traffic by sometime on Sunday. A signed detour will be in place. This closure and detour plan is similar to the plan used for previous work this past July. Traffic delays on both Route 146 and Aqueduct Road are expected during this period. Williams Street will remain open during this weekend closure, as will the Rexford Bridge and Aqueduct Road.
