

Girl Scouts Can Do

The Girl Scouts of Niskayuna will be celebrating Girl Scouting by building a structure out of cans, all of which will be donated to local food pantries to help fight hunger in the Capital District. And we could use your help.

We need to collect almost 400 standard (14.5 oz) sized cans. Our design calls for seven different colors (in order by the most to the least number of cans needed) for our design:

- Yellow (such as kidney beans, chick peas, bread crumbs)
- Green (such as leaf spinach, green beans, peas)
- Dark Orange (such as Hormel's corned beef hash)
- Light Orange (such as Pearl's sliced olives)
- Purple (such as grape jam)
- Brown (such as baked beans, sloppy joe mix)
- Red (such as tomato sauce)



We can't accept glass containers (only metal or plastic), medical supplies (only food), or alcoholic beverages.

And come watch us – and other Girl Scouts from around the Capital District – building our structures on Saturday, 14 January 2017, at the Empire State Plaza in Albany. We start building at 9:00 am and will be done around noon. The structures will be on display at the Empire State Plaza through Monday, 16 January 2017. After that, the structures will be disassembled and all of the cans used will be donated to food pantries in the Capital District.
